FACT SHEET

What: The Mission of the Breast & Cervical Cancer Project is to identify breast and cervical cancers at the earliest possible stage in underserved Ohio women.

Who is Eligible: Women with income at or below 250% of federal poverty guidelines
Uninsured
21-64 years of age for cervical screening and clinical breast exam
40 years of age and older for mammography
(25-39 years of age for breast screening and diagnostics for symptomatic or high risk with physicians orders listing reason)
**Patient Navigation services for breast or cervical screenings for any woman age 21 and up

Services Covered: Breast Self-Examination Education
Clinical Breast Exams
Mammography (Screening and Diagnostic)
Facility fee and radiology fee
Does not include any second reading by computer or radiology fee associated with computer reading
Breast Ultrasound
Fine Needle Aspiration
Surgical Consultation Visit
Breast Biopsy (Partial coverage only)
Breast MRI – Must meet coverage criteria
Pap Smears
Colposcopy with or without biopsy
Endocervical Curettage
Screening HPV with Pap test every 5 years
HPV reflex with abnormal Pap test

Services Not Covered:

Occult stools	Wet Mounts
Pelvic ultrasound	Breast Specific Gamma-Imaging
STD Testing	Vaginal or vulvar biopsies
Any blood work or urinalysis/cultures
