The CEI Foundation Vision Clinics provide free eye care for uninsured, low-income adults, in the Cincinnati and Northern KY areas.

You must have an appointment to be seen!

To qualify for clinic care, you must be:

- 18 years or older
- Have no current eye care provider
- Have no eye insurance, including Medicare
- Meet income requirements by federal government and must **bring one of the following** income verification forms listed below:
 1. W2 and/or SSA benefit verification letter
 2. Current pay stub
 3. A note signed by an agency on their letterhead stating they are assisting this patient/individual due to their low income or lack thereof
 4. Homeless certificate
 5. Food Stamp verification letter

Services Include:

- Comprehensive dilated eye exams
- Patients may receive free eyewear vouchers (a letter filled out and given to the patient on the day of exam) good at participating Lenscrafters (*a list of locations will be available at the time of appointment*).
- If prescription medication is required, we will help patients apply for free or reduced cost medications.
- At the time of the exam, if surgery or other on-going care is required, we will refer patients to the UC Eye Clinic.
